

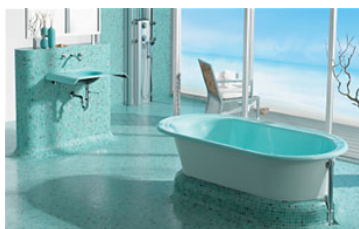


# *What's My Style - Creating My Ideal Kitchen and Bath*
